



# Plantation Primary School Year I Autumn Curriculum Map

## English

For reading we are covering the Read, Write Inc programme to help develop our phonics. As Readers, we will work our way through the programme, learning set 1, set 2 and then set 3 sounds. We will read a range of books with words containing our taught sounds in our daily phonics lessons.

As Spellers, we will recall learnt sounds and segment to spell words. We will follow the Speed Sounds word programme and Word Time as appropriate to the various levels.
As writers, following The Pathways to Write scheme, we will be learning to use sounds to spell words. We will develop our sentences to include capital letters, full stops, and gaps.

#### Maths

In Maths, we will cover:

Counting - counting to and across 100 forward and backwards.

Place value (within 10 & 20) – identify and represent numbers using pictorial representations.

Addition and subtraction (within 10)

 add and subtract one-digit and twodigit numbers to 10.

Shape – recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.

Measurement – capacity.

#### Science

As Scientists, we will be learning about 'Our Changing World' including plants, animal antics, sensing seasons and using our senses.

We will learn about everyday materials and using our senses. We will link all modules to 'Our Changing World' topics.

As Historians, we will learn about toys from the 1960's. We will explore how some toys have stayed much the same and how some toys have changed over time.
